1. The Examination is open to the following categories of candidates as "Private" candidates.

- (a) **Teachers:** They must have continuously been teachers (not honorary) in a recognized institution (Primary, Secondary, etc.) for a period of at least two academic years prior to the appearance at the examination and they must be teachers at the time of appearing at the examination. Honorary Service is not counted. No break in paid service is allowed.
- (ii) Teachers in recognized Industrial and Technical institutions are treated as teachers on the conditions mentioned in (a) above.
- (iii) Regular Teachers serving in the Army Educational Corps are deemed as teachers on the conditions mentioned in (a) above. They should also be certified as such by the Officer Commanding.
- (b) **Women Candidates:** Provided they have not studied in any recognized institution during the academic year at the end of which they wish to appear at the Examination.
- (c) **Ex-Students:** Regular Students of the Aligarh Muslim University who fail to pass the High School Examination of the University or are unable to appear at the High School Examination after having undergone a regular course of study of two academic years owing to illness of self (not detained for shortage in attendance or debarred). Such candidates shall have to enrol themselves on the prescribed form as Ex-Students by October 31, each year preceding the Examination at which they intend to appear; **Ex-Students cannot change their subjects.**
- (d) **Private Candidates in English only:** The candidates who have passed any of the following Oriental Examinations recognized by this University may apply for permission to appear as Private candidates in English only. Attested copy of the certificate of the Oriental Examination must be attached with the Application Form. No other Oriental Examinations are recognized:—
